2021 and Bills Playoff Games:

- Focus in 2021 will be balancing keeping economy going while containing virus, administering vaccine
- State will be piloting a testing plan to guide business re-openings, which will begin with Bills playoffs games
- DOH, Bills, and NFL have agreed that 6,700 fans will be allowed at the first Bills playoff game
- Masks required, and every fan will be tested prior to the game, and contact traced after the game
- No tailgating or other events permitted

- Dr. Zucker added stadium staff will be monitoring entries and exits, and will remove anyone without a documented negative test

- NYS DOH will be overseeing contact tracing after the game
- Bills owners Kim and Terry Pegula joined the briefing virtually

New COVID Strain:

- Over 4,300 tests conducted, new strain has not been found in NY

- According to CDC, new strain has been detected in Colorado

- Gov. said he is extending the law providing death benefits for families of healthcare workers who died as a result of pandemic, will be extended 30 days

Announcements:

- Empire State Trail opens tomorrow - 750 mile trail from Manhattan to Canadian border, and from Buffalo to Albany - Daniel Patrick Moynihan Train Hall ribbon cutting occurred this morning

Q&A:

- On Bills pilot testing plan, and how this might apply to indoor events:

- Gov. said challenge is that vaccine will take several months to reach critical mass, the economy cannot be closed until then

- Pilot program is examining how testing can be used to keep businesses running, but is outdoors and is a controlled venue

- Gov. said if the pilot program is successful, other venues will be considered, but indoor events require additional consideration

- On Congresswoman Ocasio-Cortez's tweet that Gov. should include small businesses in eviction moratorium EO:

- Gov. said he agrees, acknowledged the legislature passed a residential tenant eviction moratorium, but the bill does not protect commercial tenants

- Gov. said another loophole in the bill is that residential tenants are not protected from late fees and penalties, which Gov. called "extortion"

- Gov. said legislation is needed to address these issues

- On whether any refusals have been documented amongst those being vaccinated:

- Dr. Zucker said no data on this yet, but they have asked providers for the information

- The nursing home vaccination program is federally run, the state has not received information on this yet, either

- On data on nursing home deaths having not been released to the public, yet Buffalo Bills games have been given priority from DOH:

- Gov. said the pilot program is focused on creating guidance to keep businesses open and the economy running through the use of rapid testing

- On original micro-cluster zones and how those zones will be impacted by new zoning metrics:

- Gov. said despite orange zone restrictions, rates are continuing to increase in some regions
- Gov. noted that restrictions are less effective now because spread is coming from small gatherings in homes

- On when the state will make a decision on future Bills games beyond playoffs:

- Gov. said state will determine after the first pilot game depending on compliance, contact tracing
