

## Submission Guidelines

#### What is a Story Slam?

Story Slams are events that celebrate storytelling by inviting participants to share brief stories with an audience. Participants deliver stories verbally.

#### **Eligibility**

All medical students, residents, fellows, faculty and NYACP members are welcome to pitch as story for submission by sending a brief email or video about the story you want to share to the planning committee by emailing <a href="mailto:hbennett@nyacp.org">hbennett@nyacp.org</a>

#### **Preparing Your Story**

Think carefully about the story you want to share. Aim for sharing a story that conveys the fascinating, awe-inspiring, exciting, fulfilling nature of doctoring. Avoid profanity, refrain from slander, and be respectful to patients, colleagues and others mentioned in your story. Tasteful humor is welcome. Please keep in mind that the event's purpose is to share inspiring, thought-provoking stories, not stand-up comedy routines.

**Stories may last up to five (5) minutes and time limits will be strictly enforced.** You will be asked to relinquish the virtual microphone after 5 minutes even if you have not reached the end of your story to allow all presenters to take center (Zoom) stage.

#### **Permissions**

By participating in the event, you are agreeing to sign over copyright for the audio/video recordings. You may be also asked to sign a copyright agreement before the event. If you cannot mask the identity of others mentioned in your story, you will need to obtain permission from them prior to the event to identify them in your story. We need assurance that you obtained permission and can provide documentation of that permission.
