To support vaccination efforts, the ACP Board of Regents adopted a Position Statement on Immunization Policies to Protect the Public on September 14, 2021. The policy affirms the College's support for employer-based vaccination requirements, limiting exemptions to medical contraindications, and supporting ACIP, NVAC, and CDC recommendations.

ACP Partners with Women's Wellness Through Equity and Leadership to Create the New 'Women in Medicine' Supplement

ACP has partnered with the Women's Wellness Through Equity and Leadership (WEL) consortium on a new 'Women in Medicine' <u>supplement</u> which is published in the September 2021 issue of *Pediatrics*. The supplement is a multi-specialty



collection of articles based on the work of the WEL program, founded by ACP and five other medical associations, which explores challenges to improving gender equity and strategies for advancing women in medicine.

The articles address the following points:

history and challenges;

- benefits of a diverse workforce;
- advancing women to leadership positions through individual actions and institutional reform;
- building inclusive work environments;
- using metrics to promote equitable work environments; and
- supporting the advancement and retention of women physicians;

ACP's former Chair of the Board of Regents Susan Hingle, MD, MACP, FRCP, FAMWA served as a guest editor for the supplement.
