The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has created [Telemedicine Hack](#), a multi-week learning community to accelerate telemedicine implementation by ambulatory providers, with the goal of supporting wide adoption of telemedicine. The peer-to-peer learning community, taking place every Wednesday through Sept 23, 2020 from 12:00-1:00pm ET is comprised of:

- Remote learning sessions on key topics (e.g., workflows, documentation, and reimbursement) highlighting best practices and case studies from the field
- Virtual “office hour” discussion panels with case presenters, government agencies, topical experts, and stakeholder associations responding to your questions
- Inter-session peer-to-peer learning facilitated via virtual discussion boards and ad hoc interest groups
