



## **Joseph Lowy, MD**

Dr. Lowy received his Bachelor of Science from SUNY Stony Brook after which he attended the University of Florence, Italy, and the University of Rochester School of Medicine for his MD. He did his residency in internal medicine at Bellevue-NYU at the beginning of the AIDS epidemic followed by a fellowship in pulmonary and critical care medicine at UC San Diego. He joined the faculty of NYU Medical Center in pulmonary and critical care and volunteered to work for the Palliative Care service at NYU after its inception in 1999. He was appointed Director of Palliative Care, NYU Langone, in 2002. The inpatient service in Manhattan now sees approximately 2000 patients in consultation annually and has providers embedded in the Perlmutter Cancer Center as well as in the Neurology, Pulmonary and Cardiology clinics. Dr. Lowy graduated from the Montefiore-Einstein Certificate Program in Bioethics and Humanities and served as chair of the NYULMC Ethics Committee from 2015 until 2019. He is currently a member of the Ethics Consultation Service at NYU Langone.
