ADVOCACY

Meetings with Legislative and Regulatory Leaders in Anticipation of 2014 Legislative Session

In September and October, NYACP staff met with legislative and regulatory leaders to discuss pending and anticipated legislative initiatives for the upcoming legislative session.

By providing input as the New York State budget is being developed and as legislators plan their own items of interest prior to the start of the session, the Chapter is able to provide input and direction in terms of the needs of our members and the way to achieve cost effective/efficient care.

This represents the Chapter's philosophy of progressive representation in advocacy.

Chapter Participates in Workforce Advisory Group

NYACP cosponsors a Workforce Advisory Group focused on ensuring an adequately sized and well trained healthcare workforce to meet the future needs of New Yorkers. The group, represented by a variety of healthcare stakeholders, met in the beginning of October to discuss an advocacy action plan for the coming state legislative session with specific efforts to ensure funding for the Doctors Across New York program.

In addition, the NYSDOH provided updates regarding workforce training programs, and updates were given on job banks, telemedicine, and workforce as it pertains to economic development.
